Information for Members on how to use the Scheme

1. To make a booking contact the Professional or the Secretary's Office at the course you wish to visit, giving your name(s), contact telephone number and that the booking is via the 'Reciprocal Scheme'.
2. Proof of membership will be required either in the form of a handicap certificate or membership card etc.
3. On arrival, report to the Professional to pay the required green fees and present your proof of identity/membership.

Terms and Conditions

The 'Reciprocal Tee-Time Arrangement' is a reciprocal arrangement allowing members of **Beau Desert, Conwy, Llanymynech** and **The Vale of Llangollen Golf Clubs** to play a round of golf at each others Club for the prevailing member's guest rate, instead of the normal visitor's fee.

- The arrangement is unfortunately not open to Social Members;
- A Junior Member may only play under the terms of this scheme if accompanied by a Full Member.
- The arrangement is only available from Monday to Friday (excluding Bank Holidays), subject to the availability of tee times;
- The offer is only open to members of the afore mentioned clubs (you could not, for example, take a guest from another club to play with you unless they pay the full visitor rate);
- When paying green fees, evidence must be provided to prove that you are a member of one of the aforementioned clubs (a handicap certificate or membership card etc will be sufficient).
- If no proof of membership can be provided, the full visitors fee will be levied;
- The arrangement will be reviewed regularly by the participating golf clubs. Clubs may resign with 30 days notice (honouring any outstanding bookings at the reduced rate) if they feel that the costs of the arrangement outweigh the benefits to members;
- Members must adhere to the correct dress code of the course that you are visiting. Failure to do so will result in you either not being allowed to play or asked to leave the Clubhouse;
- Please be considerate when taking advantage of the offer. The Clubs will not accept more than 2 'tee' reservations per day. If more than 8 wish to play in a group, please contact the Club Secretary, who can advise you on party rates;
- Members will not be allowed under this arrangement to play at the same Club more 4 times per year.
- The participating Golf Clubs may, at any time, rescind a member's ability to take advantage of the arrangement, if it is felt that they are not adhering to the standards of behaviour of the member courses, or the spirit in which the arrangement has been set up.
